



Honours Scholarship in Plant and Soil Science

1. Purpose

Established in 2014 and maintained by the School of Agriculture and Food to support student development in the fields of Plant and Soil Science.

2. Scholarship Value and Duration

\$5,000 per annum offered for one scholarship.

3. Eligibility for Scholarship

The scholarship is open to students who:

- a) Have enrolled or intend to enrol in the Bachelor of Agricultural Science (Honours) or Bachelor of Science (Honours) program fulltime; and
- b) Completing a research project in either the field of agronomy, crop production, plant biology, plant science, plant protection or urban horticulture.
- c) Have completed a Bachelor's degree in either Agricultural Science, Sustainable Agriculture, Science or completing their final year of the Bachelor of Agricultural Science (Honours) or equivalent.

4. Selection of Scholarship

Scholarships will be awarded to the applicants showing the greatest merit based on:

- a) Academic merit in their Bachelor's degree of a minimum GPA of 5.0
- b) Leadership and involvement in community services
- c) Passion and commitment to plant and soil science.

5. Supporting Documentation

Applications must include the following supporting documentation:

- a) Copy of student academic transcript
- b) Evidence of leadership and community service with a supporting statement from an appropriate referee.
- c) Personal statement outlining their passion and commitment in plant and soil science (200 words maximum) including personal outcomes/goals planned during the period of the Scholarship.

6. Application Process

Please complete all sections of the application form including signatures and ensure that supporting documentation is attached. Completed submissions are to be emailed to agriculture@enquire.uq.edu.au.

Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.

The Selection Committee may decide to interview short-listed applicants, and their determination will be considered final; no further communication will be entered into. All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their application. Successful recipients may be required to participate in student mentoring and promotional activities associated with the award of the Honours Scholarship in Plant and Soil Science.
