This Learning Contract must be completed by all students wishing to undertake AGRC7200 Graduate Research Topic, in consultation with the supervisor.

AGRC7200 is an advanced course of **desktop-based** literature review in a specialist area relevant to the student's program and conducted under the supervision of an academic staff member. Students are expected to be sufficiently advanced in their program to be able to benefit from an in-depth investigation of a topic of interest to them. They are also expected to have suitable literature retrieval skills (or to seek them with assistance from the library staff) and presentation skills.

To enrol in this course, students must email their completed Graduate Research Topic Learning Contract to agriculture@enquire.uq.edu.au by the first Thursday of February if enrolling in the course in semester 1, or the first Thursday of July for students enrolling in the course in semester 2.

The assessments in this course are a **Literature Review** and a **Presentation** (recorded). See the course profile for assessment weightings, submission due dates and details. As a guide, students are expected to spend 7 – 10 hours per week on this 2-unit course. Students must arrange to meet regularly with their supervisor, preferably weekly, at a mutually agreeable time.
